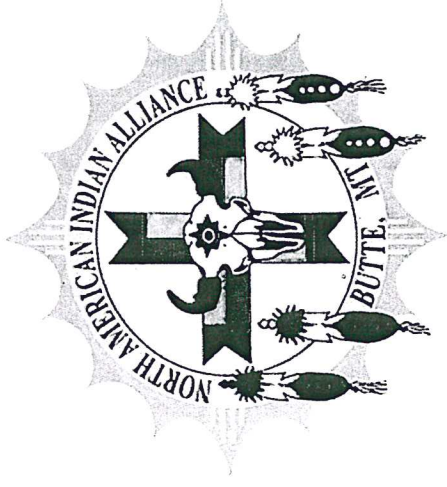
Health Program

- ◇ Limited Optical Services
- ◇ Limited Dental Services
- ◇ Women's Wellness
- ◇ Immunizations
